## RESOLUTION 97-1 DILLON VALLEY DISTRICT

Re: Water and Sewer Service to Out-of-District Customers

The Dillon Valley District will offer either water or sewer service or both services to properties outside the boundaries of the District under the following conditions:

- A. The District's engineer must recommend approval as to location, service capability, and design.
  - B. All the District's engineering expenses must be pre-paid by the applicant.
  - C. The size of the water and sewer lines will be determined by the District.
- D. Once installed, approved by the District's engineer, and accepted by the board of directors of the District, the District will own and maintain the lines to the service connection, and the property owner will maintain the line between the service connection and the house.
- E. If the owner is not immediately adjacent to the District, the District will consider payback agreements for reimbursement to the property owner as additional people connect to the line. Any such payback agreement must be administered by the District and will have a term of ten years.
- F. The main line servicing the property must be extended, at the property owners expense, to the furthest boundary line on the side of the lot being served.
- G. The rules and regulations of the District will be enforced as fully as if the property were within the District.
- H. Service fees and tap fees will be 150% of those in effect in the District at the time service is extended.
- I. The District reserves the right to refuse service to anyone, even if the terms of this Resolution are acceptable to the applicant, if, in the sole discretion of the District's board of directors, the extension of service does not serve the best interests of the District.
