2021 USER RATES The Dillon Valley District bills in arrears. This billing is for the 2nd Quarter 2021 – April 1st through June 30th.

Sewer	\$ 136 per quarter per EQR
Water	\$ 104.25 per quarter per unit base rate plus usage
Water usage	0 to 15,000 gallons \$5.24 per 1,000 gallons
	15,001 to 25,000 gallons \$6.55 per 1,000 gallons
	25,001 to 50,000 gallons \$7.87 per 1,000 gallons
	50,001 to 75,000 gallons \$10.47 per 1,000 gallons
	Over 75,000 gallons \$13.11 per 1,000 gallons

The 2021 rates reflect an approximate quarterly increase for most users of 4.7%. The rate increase was primarily to continue to build reserve funds for water and sewer line improvements.

IRRIGATION USAGE The summer irrigation season has begun with dryer weather. Seasonal July and August weather patterns can bring afternoon showers that can reduce your irrigation needs. Outside water use can greatly increase the amount of water used by a home in a quarter. Irrigation done correctly, can maintain suitable landscaping at a reasonable water cost. This billing does include any irrigation usage during May and June. The next billing for the months of July, August and September could reflect irrigation in all three months. Unusually high outside water usage may be from poor irrigation practices including daily watering or leaking of your irrigation equipment. Now is the time to have your irrigation system checked. Hint: Watering during windy periods or in the middle of the day is ineffective and wastes water as it evaporates before it hits the ground. Overwatering can lead to poor quality lawns and plants.

VOLUNTARY WATER RESTRICTIONS

The voluntary water restrictions for the Dillon Valley District from May 1st to October 1st are:

- ❑ Outside usage is not allowed on Mondays
- ❑ The water days for properties whose street address ends in an odd number are Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.
- ❑ The water days for properties whose street address ends in an even number, including 0, are Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.
- ❑ Outside usage is not allowed between the hours of 12 PM and 5 PM.
- ❑ DO NOT water the gutter or road. Make sure your sprinkler is only watering your lawn.
- ❑ Never run an open hose. Always use a nozzle with a shut-off.
- ❑ Hand watering, using either a watering can or a hose with a shut off nozzle is ALLOWED at anytime (no restrictions as to days or time).
- ❑ Don't overwater your lawn; step on the grass; if it springs back up when you move your foot, it does not need water.
